<u>APPEARANCE</u>

Learners must at all times meet the standards of neatness and hygiene acceptable to the educators of the school.

1. HAIR

Hair must be clean and tidy. No distracting, trendy, or atypical hairstyles are allowed. Learners must be considerate at all times of their fellow pupils (sitting behind or next to them in class) and the academic atmosphere of the school, thus:

1.1 GIRLS

- Hair may not cover the eyes if styled forward.
- Loose strands of hair may not touch the ears or the collar of the learner's school shirt.
- Longer hair (that touches the collar of a learner's shirt) must be neatly, properly and completely tied - not half up and half down.
- Fringes may not reach below the eyebrows.
- Hair may not be shaved into patterns.
- Hair may be shaved off.
- Use of hair gel is allowed.
- Dyed hair, highlights, extensions and braids are only allowed in shades of a natural hair colour
- Ombre and dip dye is a trend and therefore will not be allowed.
- No visible regrowth will be allowed.
- Hair clips and pompoms must be in a shade of the learner's hair or in the colours of our school uniform.
- No <u>big</u> ornamental flowers or bows, hairclips and broad headbands are allowed.
- Undercuts are only allowed with NO PATTERNS.
- No hair embellishments are allowed.

1.2 BOYS

- Side burns are allowed to reach mid ear only.
- Boys must be clean shaven.
- Hair may not touch eyebrows if styled forward.
- Hair may not touch the ears or the collar of the learner's school shirt.
- Hair may not be shaved into patterns.
- Hair may be shaved off.
- Use of hair gel is allowed.
- Fringes may not reach below the eyebrows and hair, if combed straight down the sides of the face, may not cover the ears.
- · Boys must be clean-shaven every day.
- Longer hair must be properly and completely tied not half up and half down
- Hair clips and pompoms must be in a shade of the learner's hair or in the colours of our school uniform.
- Dyed hair, highlights, extensions and braids are only allowed in shades of a natural hair colour
- Ombre and dip dye is a trend and therefore will not be allowed.
- No visible regrowth will be allowed.
- Hair styled upward in a moderate afro/braided or in dreadlocks must adhere to the above regulations.

2. JEWELRY

No rings, bracelets, ankle jewellery or necklaces may be worn.

Only 1 pair of normal sized sleepers or studs may be worn in only the bottom piercing of the earlobe.

Only a watch or allergy bracelet may be worn.

No piercings other than earrings (see above) are allowed.

Plasters worn over incorrect piercings will not exempt a learner from being punished for wearing earrings in the incorrect piercing

Boys are only allowed to wear ear rings if they are covered by plasters

GENERAL

- School and sport uniforms must be neat and clean every day.
- Shoes must be polished daily.
- "Tomy" tackies and "pumps" are not allowed.
- Only prescribed school uniform is allowed No other coats, jackets, scarves, beanies or gloves may be worn.
- Sunglasses are not allowed to be worn in class.
- Nails: Only transparant, colourless nail polish is permitted.

- Nails must be short and neat at all times and not be visible over the fingertips while looking at the palm of the hand
- Make-up is not permitted.
- No brightly coloured underwear or camisole under white shirt.
- No visible writing / tattoos on any part of the body. (Should be concealed under clothing not simply covered with plasters)
- Uniform should be correctly worn before school, after school, outside school gates and at extra-mural activities as it is the view of our school that we give to the public.

If a learner does not wear the prescribed school uniform at school or in public, demerits may be given. If a learner is forced to wear an incorrect item due to unforeseen circumstances, a letter from the parent must be presented to the relevant Grade head during administration class. Incorrect jewellery and clothing items may be confiscated.
